## From the Pen of Pastor Stan:

### IS HEAVEN A REAL, PHYSICAL PLACE?

I recently reread a book by Dr. David Jeremiah entitled: *Answers to Questions About Heaven*. It's a little book packed with a lot of information about Heaven. In case you don't get a chance to read the book, I thought it would be a good idea to share a few excerpts from his book over the next few weeks.

The first question that Dr. Jeremiah addresses in his book is: Is heaven a real, physical place? Dr. Jeremiah writes:

Heaven is no figment of the imagination, nor is it a feeling, a state of mind, or the invention of man. Heaven is a literal place prepared by Christ for a prepared people. In John Chapter 14, Jesus Himself left His disciples with this promise: In my Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. (John 14:2-30)

From this passage we can have full confidence that heaven is a real, physical place—a place where believers will one day reside with their Savior!
